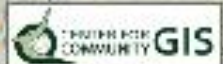
- Great blue heron colonies

- Tidal waterfowl and wading bird habitat
- Inland waterfowl and wading bird habitat
- Contiguous large forest blocks (>500 acres and >500 feet from roads or development)
